NEW POSTPARTUM SUPPORT GROUP

We are excited to announce the launch of a new support group for postpartum depression (PPD), starting on April 24th. This group will provide a safe and supportive space for new mothers navigating postpartum mental health challenges. Led by Jessica Cotton, LPC, Kristen Kite, and Shelby Weston, who oversee After Baby, this group is designed to meet the needs of the 62% of our After Baby clients who have been assessed with a high probability of suffering from postpartum depression (PPD). Treating PPD is crucial for a mother's well-being and preventing child abuse and neglect, as untreated PPD can lead to increased stress, emotional distress, and difficulty bonding, negatively impacting both mother and child.

In addition to screening our After Baby moms for PPD and offering individual counseling, our hope is that this group will offer these women the chance to be part of a healthy community, learn together, and form connections outside of WHG. Serving these women also means serving their families as they overcome PPD and develop into better versions of themselves
