FROM THE DESK OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR: BECAUSE OF YOU, HOPE WAS BORN

At Wiregrass Hope, we often say, "We never know what a day will bring." This summer, one of those days brought us a woman whose story reminded us why we do what we do and why your support matters more than ever.

She came to us in her late 40s, quiet and weary. Years ago, she had a life many would envy: a husband, a home, and a beautiful son with special needs. But life unraveled. She lost her husband, her job, her home, and eventually custody of her son. Alone and broken, she found herself homeless on the streets of Dothan.

A man offered her shelter, a shed behind his house, in exchange for food and favors. When she became pregnant, he cast her out. She came to Wiregrass Hope early in her pregnancy, desperate and afraid. But without transportation or a stable place to stay, we lost touch with her.

Months passed. Then, unexpectedly, we received word: she had given birth several weeks early to a strong, healthy baby girl. Despite minimal prenatal care, this little one was a miracle. But the hospital couldn't release the baby without a plan for her safety.

We met with social workers and a Christian adoption agency to explore every option. But this mama, despite all she'd endured, was determined to raise her child. Through the Lord's provision and your generosity, we secured her a place at a Care-Net affiliated maternity home in northern Alabama, a haven for vulnerable mothers preparing for independent living.

I had the privilege of helping them discharge from the hospital and personally transporting them to their new home. As I drove, I watched a mother loving on her newborn in my backseat with a quiet strength that only God could restore. They will live together for up to two years with support, building a future, one step, one prayer, one day at a time.

This story is yours too. Because of you, this mama and her baby have hope. Because of you, love triumphed over despair.

We're seeing more and more young mothers who are homeless or housing-insecure. That's why we're pursuing a partnership with Love in Action in downtown Dothan to establish a satellite location adjacent to their Samaritan's Medical Clinic every Thursday afternoon. But to make this possible, we need more volunteer mentors, people willing to walk alongside these moms and dads, offering guidance, compassion, and hope.

If you feel led to join us in this life-changing ministry, please reach out. Whether at our main office or through this new outreach, your presence could be the answer to someone's prayer.

Thank you for being the heartbeat of Wiregrass Hope. Some days look different. Some days break our hearts. But every day, because of you, we get to be part of God's redemptive work.
